

Our Program

Kaleidoscope, ABA, Inc., is a unique school for children with an autism spectrum disorder. Our program combines one-on-one therapy with systematic progress evaluation to foster the development of our children to their highest potential.

We offer:

- ❖ Center-based programming five days per week, twelve months per year
- ❖ Ongoing supervision and weekly program adaptation
- ❖ Ongoing parent support
- ❖ Two programs: Our early learner program and our advanced learner program for ABLLS graduates focused on classical academics using applied behavior analysis teaching principles.
- ❖ Open door policy for parents of enrolled children

We accept children two to eight years of age, of all skill levels and abilities.



Our school is located in downtown Canton, Georgia, off highway 575.

Our Curriculum

We place strong emphasis on language acquisition and development of intraverbal skills. Our teaching approach is systematic and targeted to maximize rate of skill acquisition. The curriculum is based on Sundberg and Partington's Assessment of Basic Language and Learning Skills, and Skinner's analysis of verbal behavior using natural environment teaching.



Our learning environment

- ❖ Motivates and engages children
- ❖ Uses the child's own motivation and positive reinforcement to promote development
- ❖ Teaches new skills using an errorless learning format to maximize success and minimize failure
- ❖ Stimulates the child to initiate communication

We evaluate progress by performance of quarterly Assessment of Basic Language and Learning Skills.

Above all, we believe that practicing skills in the home setting is essential for success. We fully support parents in this effort through frequent communication, and updates on their child's progress.

Areas of targeted development

- ❖ Receptive language (responding to language)
- ❖ Expressive language (spoken language)
- ❖ Spontaneous language use
- ❖ Cognitive and academic skills
- ❖ Social and play skills
- ❖ Self-help skills
- ❖ Gross and fine-motor skills

Two levels of programming:

Our Early Learner Program is focused heavily on language acquisition. All instruction is provided one to one for all of the child's learning time. We use errorless teaching, positive reinforcement and natural environment teaching.

Our Advanced Learner Program serves children who have completed 75% of the ABLLS curriculum and communicate readily through spoken or written language.

The focus of this program is on advanced intraverbal (conversation) skills and classical academics for the child who learns in a non-traditional manner.

All teaching is provided using applied behavior analysis principles to teach Math, Grammar and Spelling, Science, History and visual arts. Instruction is provided in a 1:1 and 1:2 format depending on the child's needs.



We believe...

- ... every child with an Autism disorder can learn and develop given appropriate instruction
- ... high quality behavioral teaching is crucial for a child's successful outcome
- ... a child learns best when new skills are broken down into small steps so the child experiences success each day
- ... excess inappropriate behaviors decrease when appropriate language and social skills are learned
